There were some particularly good exhibits of high quality although the season has not been the kindest to growers. An excellent large white Decorative – Snow White was the supreme exhibit. It just pipped one of the best Exhibition Cactus I have seen over the last few seasons. There was not the scarcity of petals so often seen and top balanced bottom. Exhibits to catch the eye, other than the two already mentioned were Devon radiance, Scarborough 2000, Wakefield Conclusion, and a well balanced exhibit of Araluen Fire, a couple of very nice singles and in the seedling class a red anemone. The latter may be not everyone's cup of tea as it is a single with an anemone centre. However the outer florets did what they should and I hope we see more of this on the bench. The Special Class was a real feature with Bracken Sarah showing all its variations of colour and size. The people's choice would have been without doubt Alessia – Fimbriated Cactus. This has the colour combination of a Maggie Hannaford but in fimbriated form. The substance of the blooms shown I feel surpassed many of the other Fims that have graced benches. Look out for this one.

I congratulate the exhibitors for staging exhibits of the quality they did considering it is near the flowering season's conclusion.
